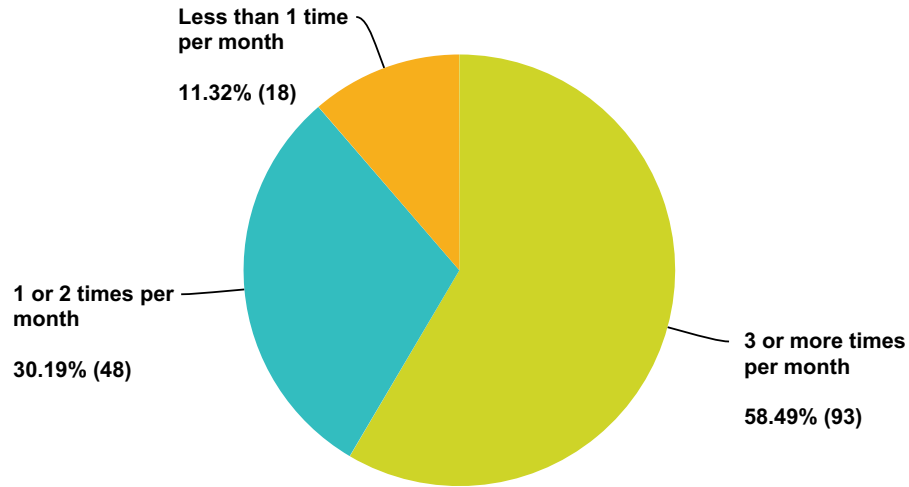


Q1 During the last year, approximately how often have you attended UUCB on Sunday morning, either as an attendee or as a Lifespan Faith Development teacher?

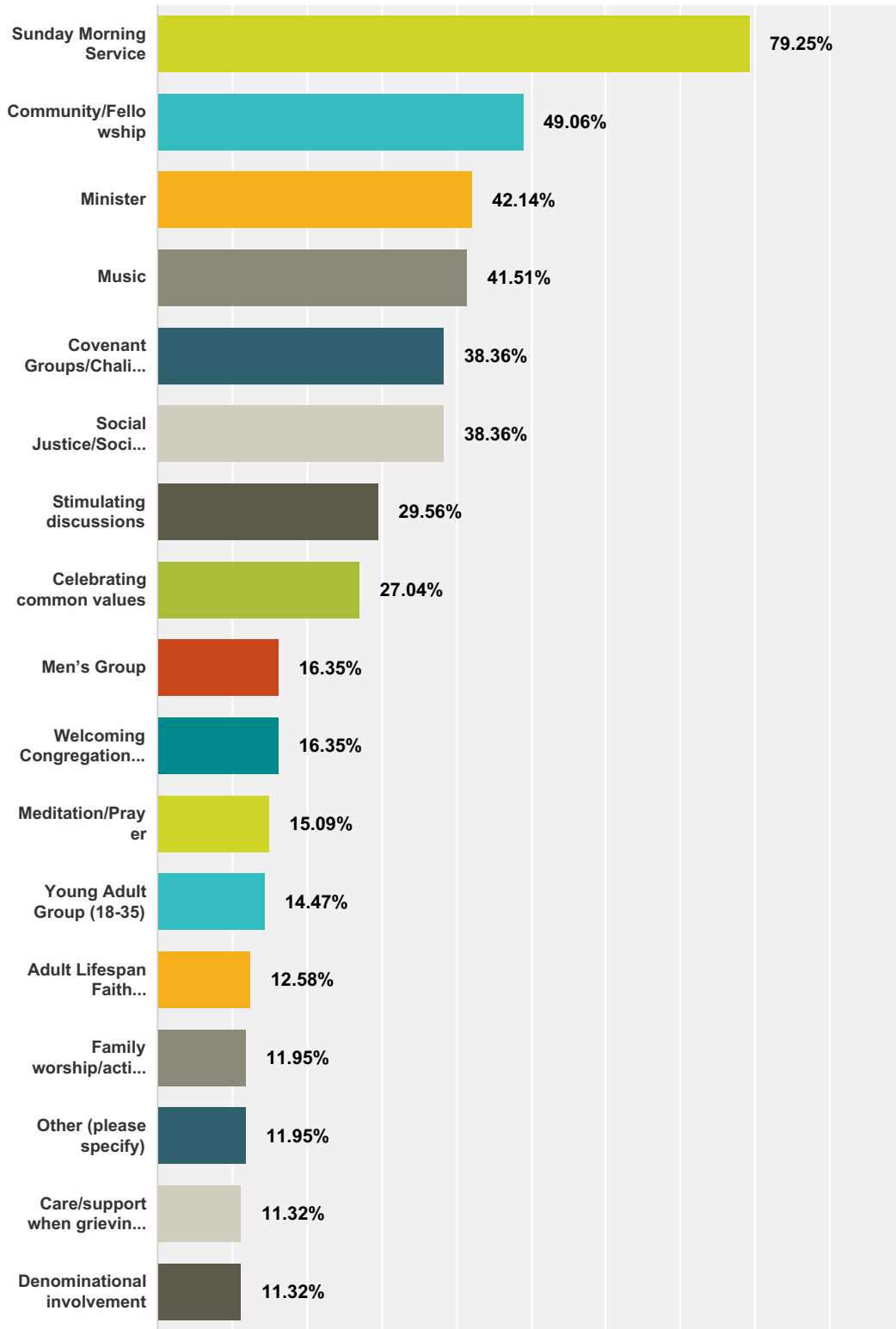

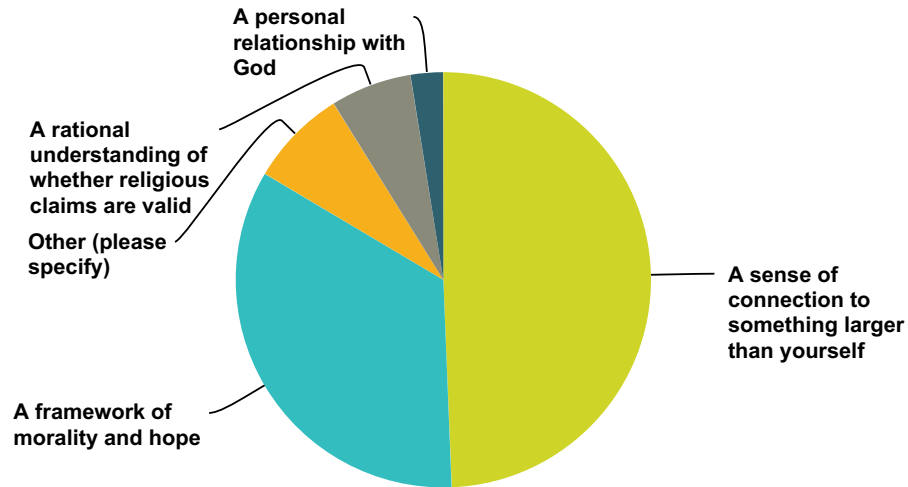

Q8 When you think about motivations for your faith/spirituality, what is your foremost concern? Check one (1).

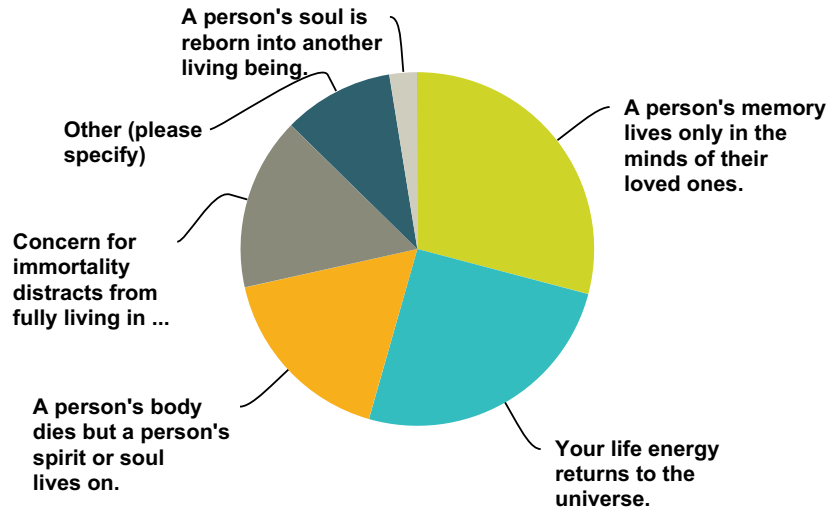

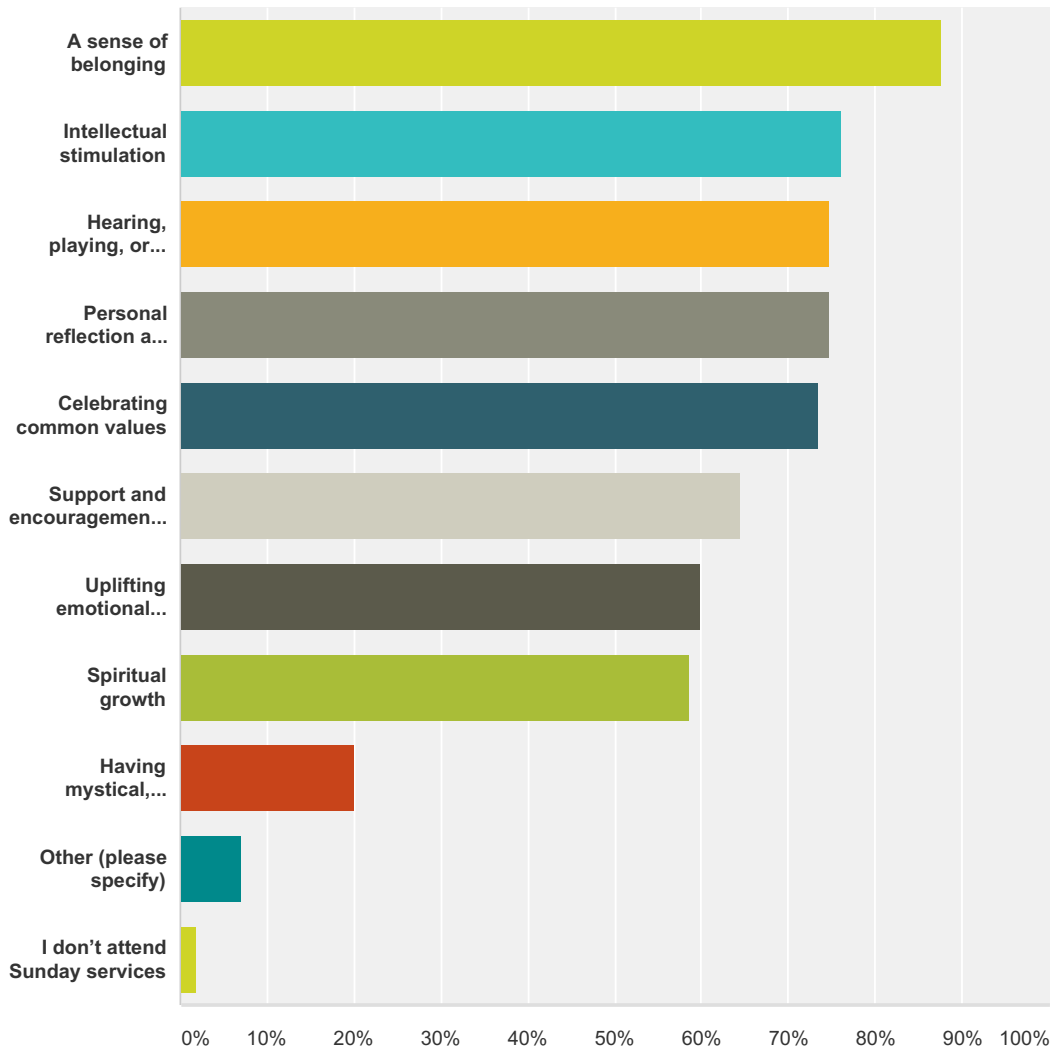

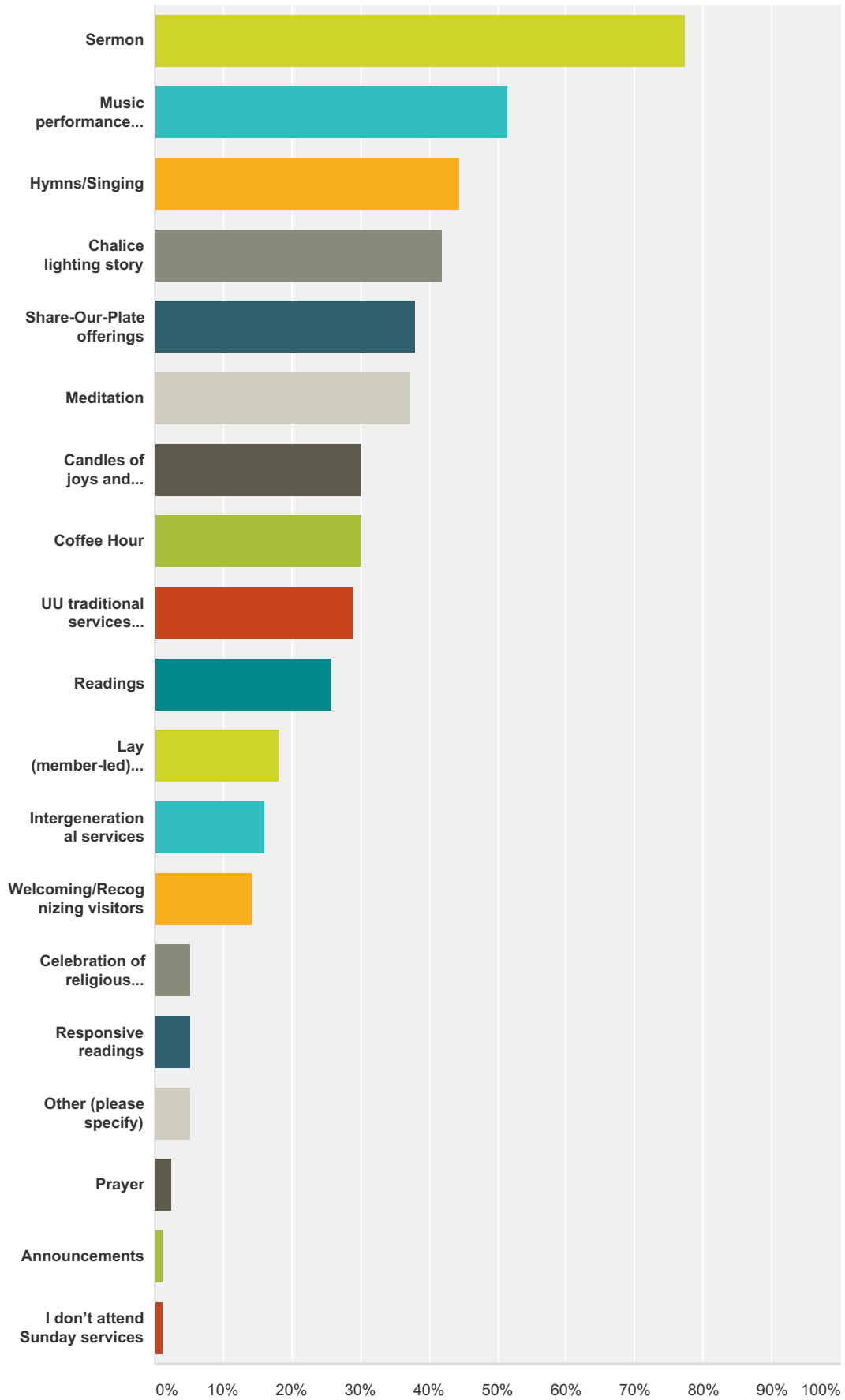

Q12 When you attend Sunday worship services, which of the following practices and traditions are most important to you? Check no more than five (5).

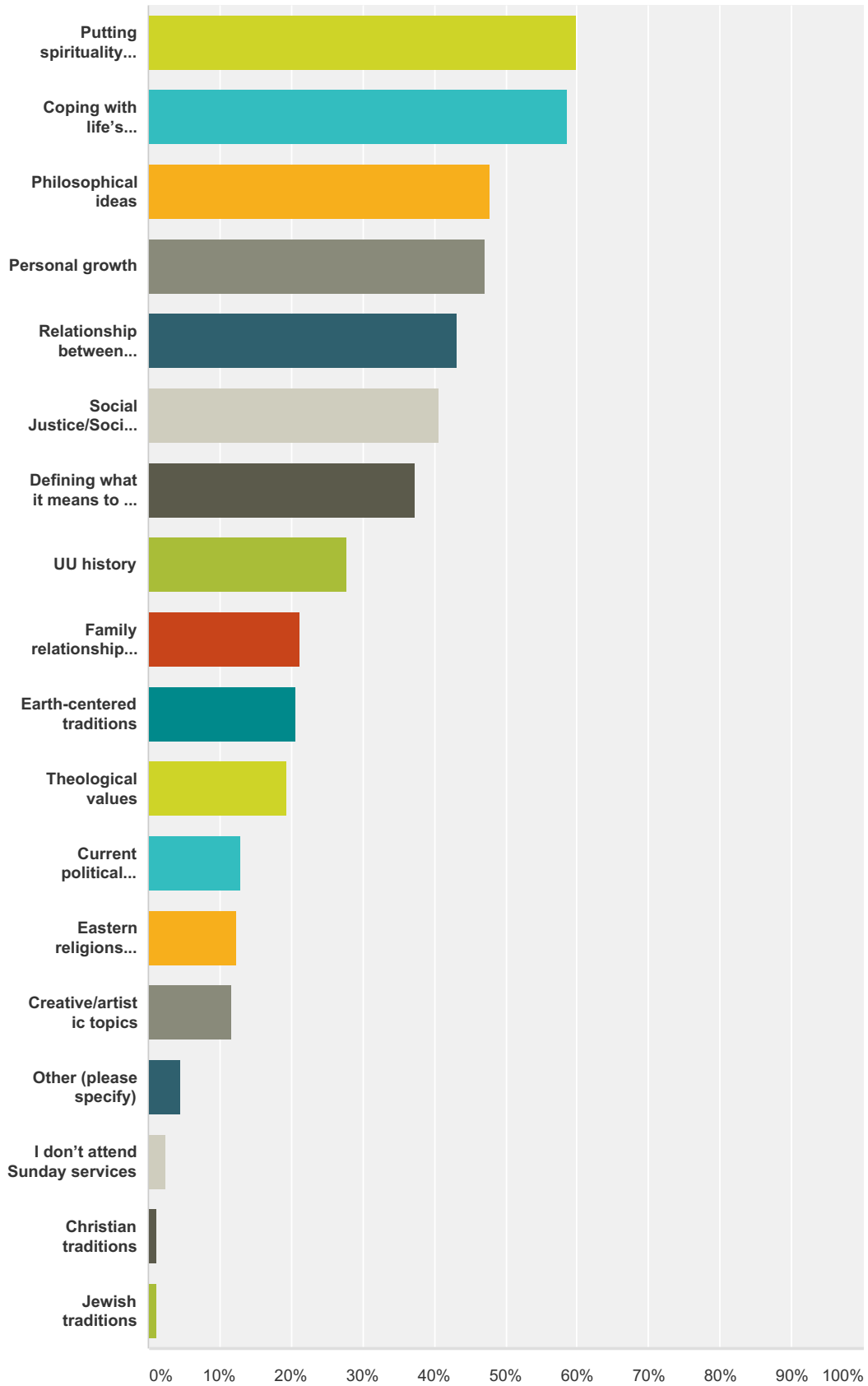

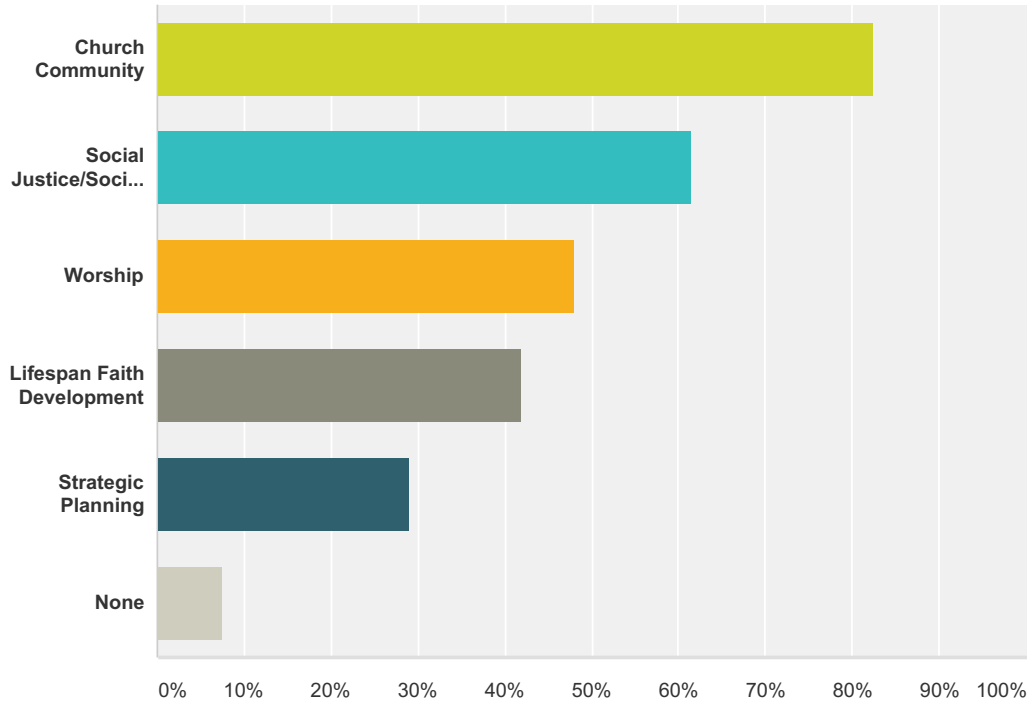

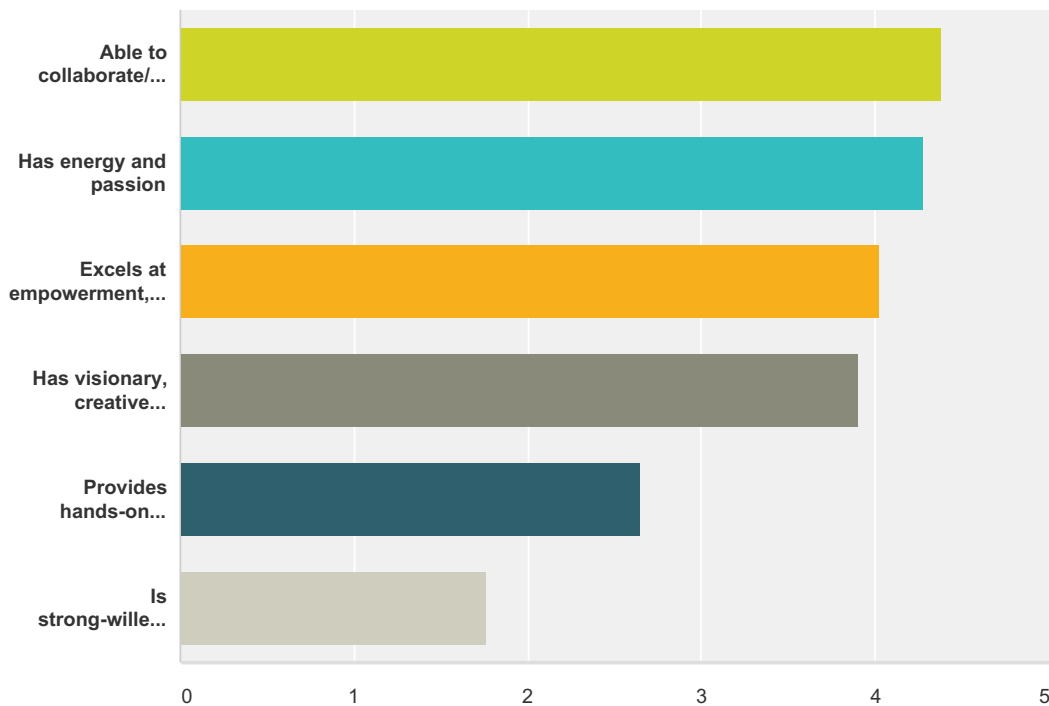

Q21 In which areas of church life does our congregation already contribute strong lay (member-led) ministry? Check all that apply.

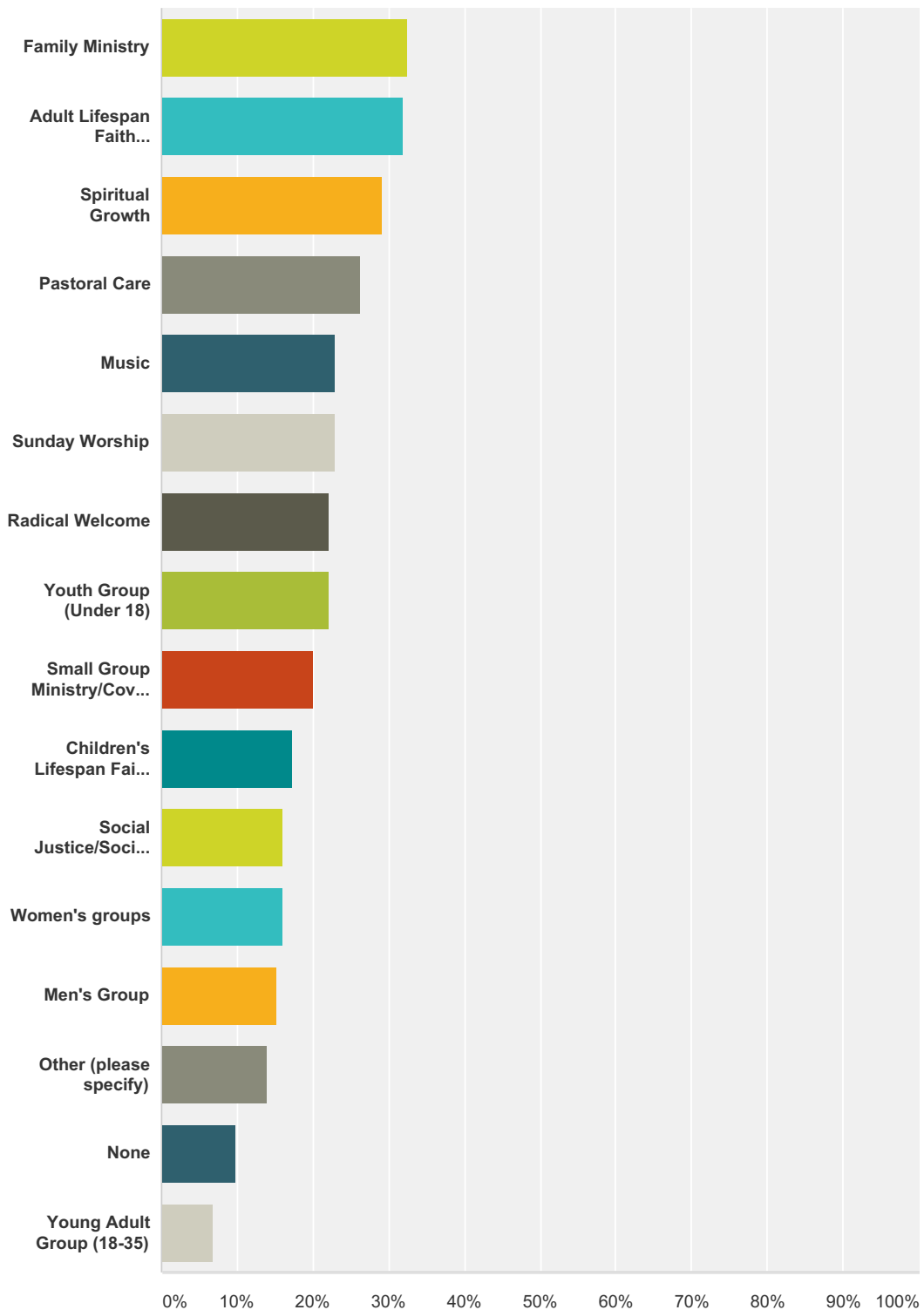

Q22 In which areas of church life does our congregation have untapped potential for lay (member-led) ministry? Check all that apply.

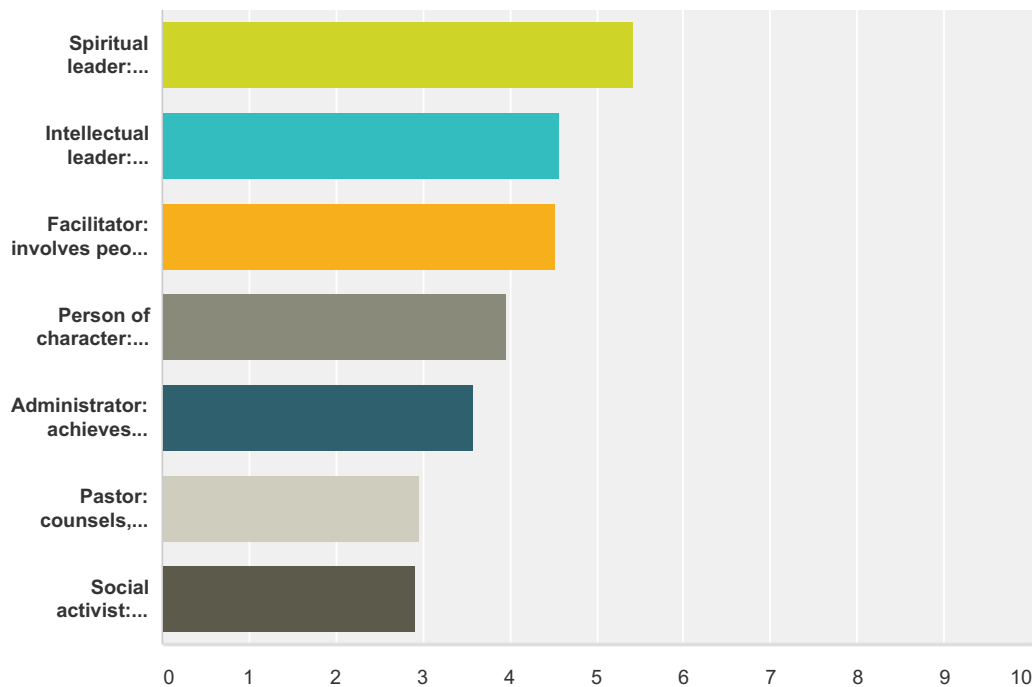

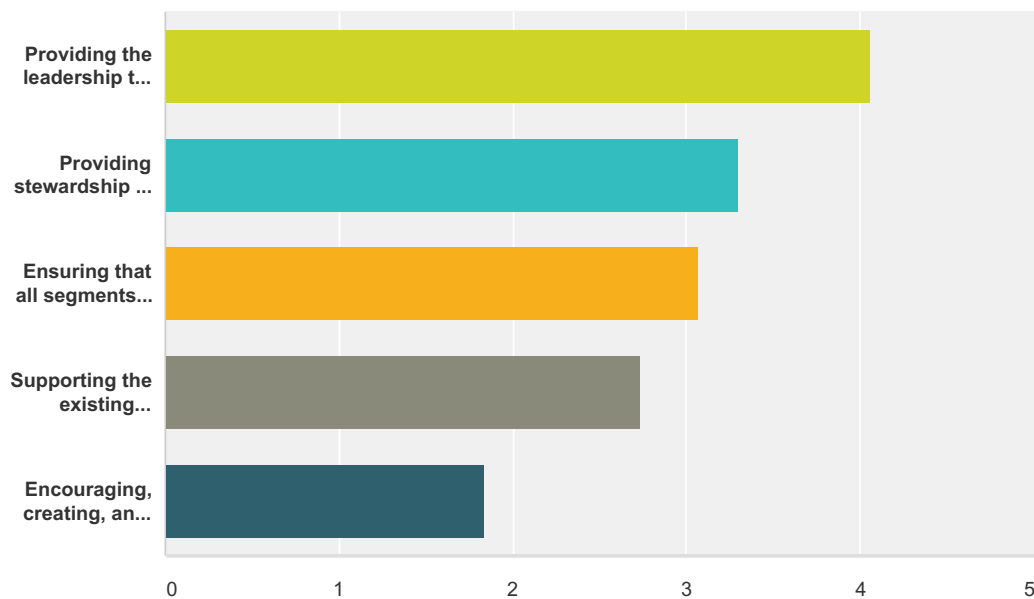

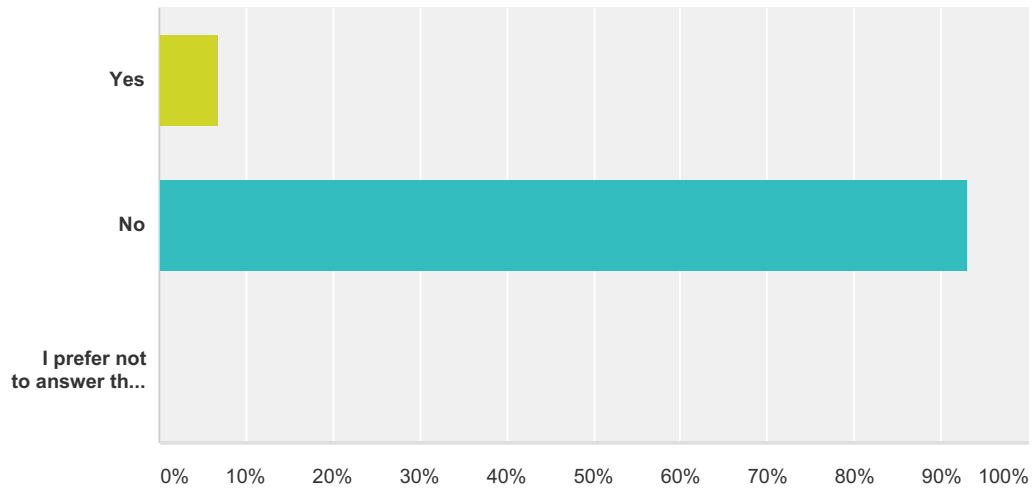

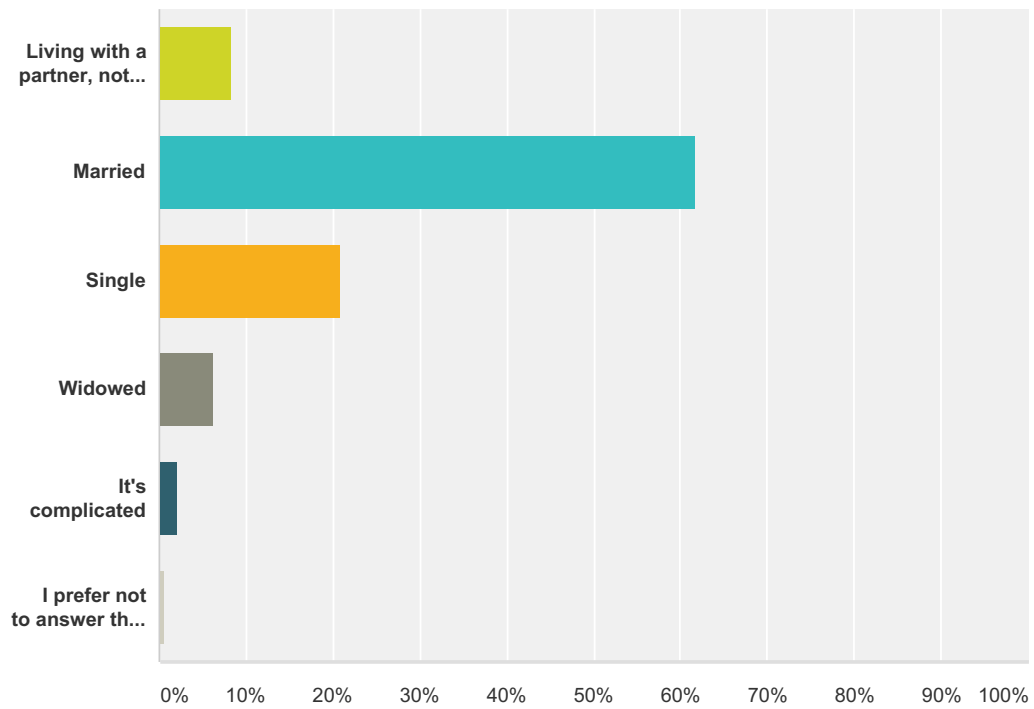

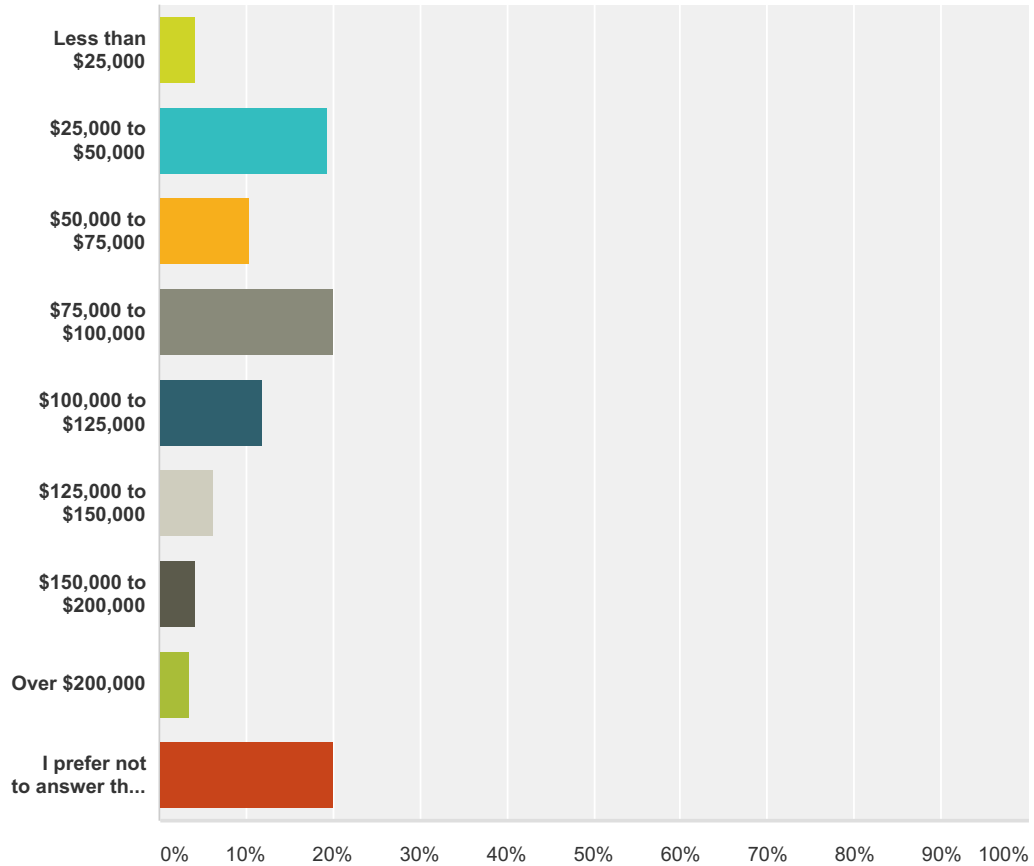

Q31 What was your total gross family/household income before taxes last year?

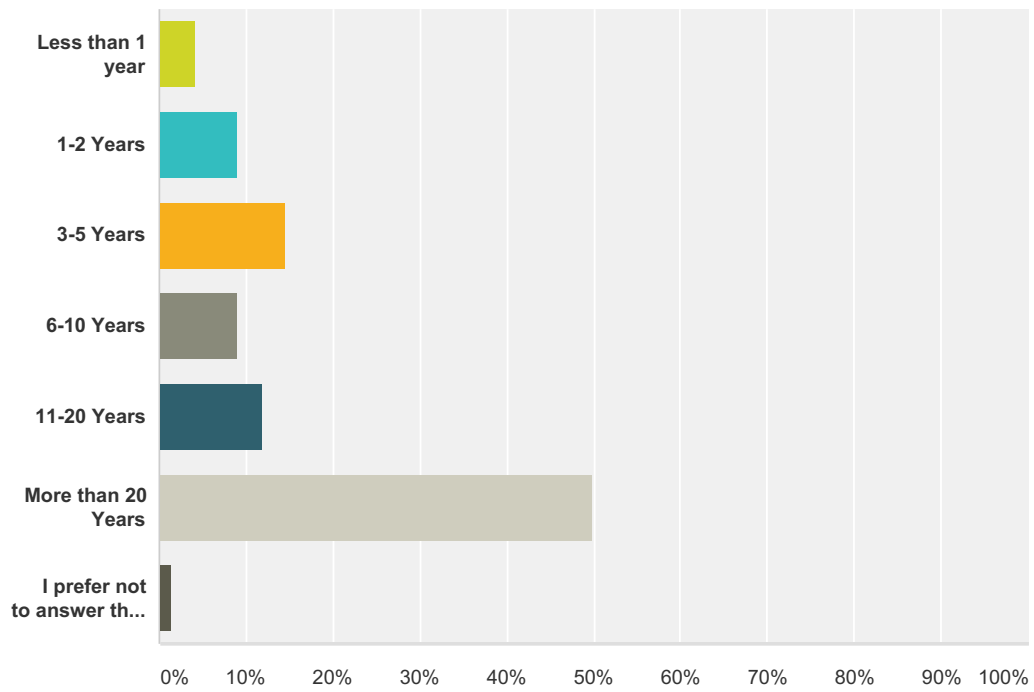

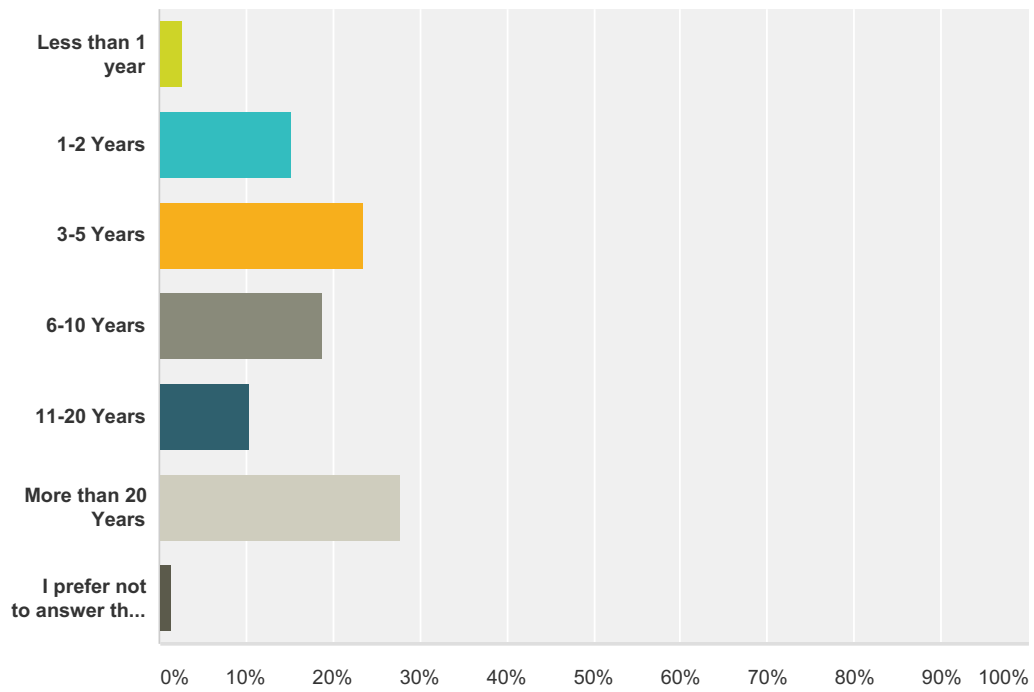

Q35 How long does it take you to travel to church on Sunday?

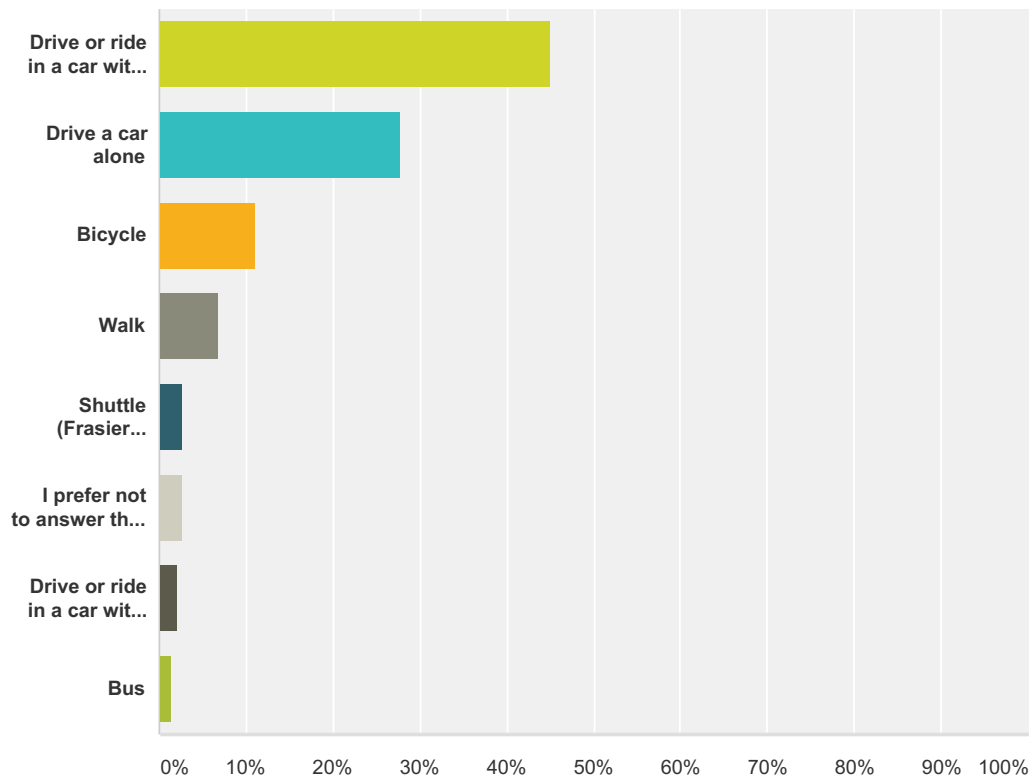
