Context: In April, the Religious Affairs Committee (RAC) of the NAACP of Boulder County hosted the Solidarity Dividend: Continuing the Community Conversation at Congregation Har Hashem as a follow-up to reading "The Sum of Us" by Heather McGee. Conversation: Break into groups based on these topics to discuss the following questions from the first stage of the Truth, Racial Healing & Transformation (TRHT) "Community Visioning & Planning:"

- 1. What will your community look and feel like after racism has ended?
- 2. What are the current racial realities of your community and how did you get here?
- 3. What are the key leverage points of change in your community?
- 4. Who are the key stakeholders and beneficiaries not at the table? How can they be engaged?
- 5. What specific actions can be taken to achieve your vision of a community without racism?
- 6. What's next what meaningful action can be taken?
