Did you know that the Colorado Constitution has a ban on marriage for same-sex couples!? Narrowly passed by voters in 2006, the Colorado Constitution defines marriage as between one man and one woman. If Obergefell - the 2015 U.S. Supreme Court decision that made marriage equality the law of the land - is overturned same-sex marriage would no longer be legal in Colorado. Without Obergefell or new federal protections, future same-sex marriages would not be legal in the state of Colorado.

This November, Colorado voters have a chance to ensure that same-sex couples can continue to get married in our state by voting on Amendment J! Which means that YOU can get involved to help protect the Freedom to Marry!
